## Del Prado Circle Construction

As we all know, there has been construction taking place on Del Prado Circle. The official name of the project is Del Prado Circle at Palmetto Circle Intersection and Sidewalk Improvements. This project is meant to provide intersection, drainage and sidewalk improvements.

The project was approved for over \$1,000,000 by Palm Beach County Commissioners on September 12, 2023, and the contract time is 360 days. El Leon Construction, Inc. is the contractor to whom the project was awarded. While I think we can all agree that this project is a bit of a nuisance, it promises to improve local walking and driving when completed.

## Snowbird Season
