## Florida MV Express

Did you know that you can renew your motor vehicle registration while you shop? In the front of Publix on W. Palmetto Park Road, near the check-out area, you will find a vehicle registration self-serve kiosk. In partnership with Intellectual Technology Inc. (ITI), the Florida MV Express kiosks give residents the ability to renew registrations immediately, with registrations and decals printed on the spot. Easy-to-use on-screen prompts can lead you through the process in as little as two minutes. A 2.3% credit card service fee and \$4.50 convenience fee applies.
